Hebrews 11:29

By faith they passed through the Red Sea as by dry land, whereas the Egyptians, attempting to do so, were drowned.

But God stopped him, and told him what to do: *"...Moses, "Why are you crying out to me?... Raise your staff and stretch out your hand over the sea to divide the water..."* (Exodus 14:15-16 NIV). 


