

The Holy Spirit is the third Person of the Godhead—He's the very Spirit of God. He'll give you power to win and help you live out God's big plan for your life (Acts 1:8).

In the Bible's original Greek, He's called *Allos Parakletos*, which means "another Comforter just like Jesus." This means He is sent to be with you always as your Comforter, Counselor, Teacher, Helper, Strengtheners, Intercessor, and Friend.

The only requirement to receive Him is to be born again (Acts 2:38–39).






